

EXPERT WORKSHOP ON THE MEASUREMENT OF DIGITAL WORK

Objective

The recent, explosive growth of the 'sharing economy' and of new forms of work and the impacts of digitisation on labour markets have created new challenges for statistics producers and users. The aim of this workshop is to bring together experts to share knowledge and views about:

- What is already known? (From existing surveys and administrative data)
- What additional information do we need to know?
- What instruments could be used to collect this information, and how feasible would it be to add questions to existing surveys to capture it?

The main aim is to encourage free and open discussion, in particular between statistics producers and statistics users. All participants are invited to make short presentations (maximum ten minutes) to share results from past work, details from work in progress or plans for future work.
